Before you visit

Please ensure you liaise with your Treloar's colleague before arranging a visit.

Once you have confirmation of your visit :-

On arrival:

- Parking – Please park in the Visitors Car Park.
- Parking – if the visitors car park is full, please buzz at the barrier and follow signs to the main car park.
- Visitors must comply with all health and safety procedures including adhering to the site speed limit of 10mph at all times.
- Please make your way to reception – at the green gate you will need to call to gain entry.



- Please follow the signs to reception and press the intercom.
- Go to reception and sign in.
- You will be asked to provide formal identification before being issued with a visitor's badge and yellow lanyard which needs to be displayed at all times during your visit.
- Please remain with your host at all times.
- Please keep all personal belongings with you at all times.
- Please be aware that the majority of our students are wheelchair users whose wheelchairs can move swiftly.
- At the end of your visit, please sign out at reception and return your badge and lanyard.



Safeguarding children and adults

If you are concerned about a student, the behaviour of anyone on site (staff, student or visitor) or any other event that could impact on our students, then you must immediately report this to the Head of Safeguarding on 07825 262 418 (available 24 hours, 365 days per year).

Safeguarding is everybody's responsibility, including visitors. Our main priority is to make certain that everyone who visits Treloar's is aware of their responsibility towards ensuring all young people are safe. We will do our best to provide you with an enjoyable visit, but ask you to please comply with the following requests:



When in any learning environment we ask that you:

- Respect the educational process by refraining from interacting with the teacher/session lead or students in any learning environment during the visit unless invited to do so.
- Be discreet and as unobtrusive as possible to avoid diverting focus away from students' learning.
- Ensure that all mobile phones are switched off
- Save any questions until the end of the learning session.
- Make any information acquired during the visit available to Treloar's staff on request.



When in any learning environment visitors must not:

- Photograph or video any student or any member of staff.
- Take any recordings in any format.
- Record information without prior consent.
- Publish in any format any information about students or staff acquired during the visit without prior consent.
- Publish any information on social media.
