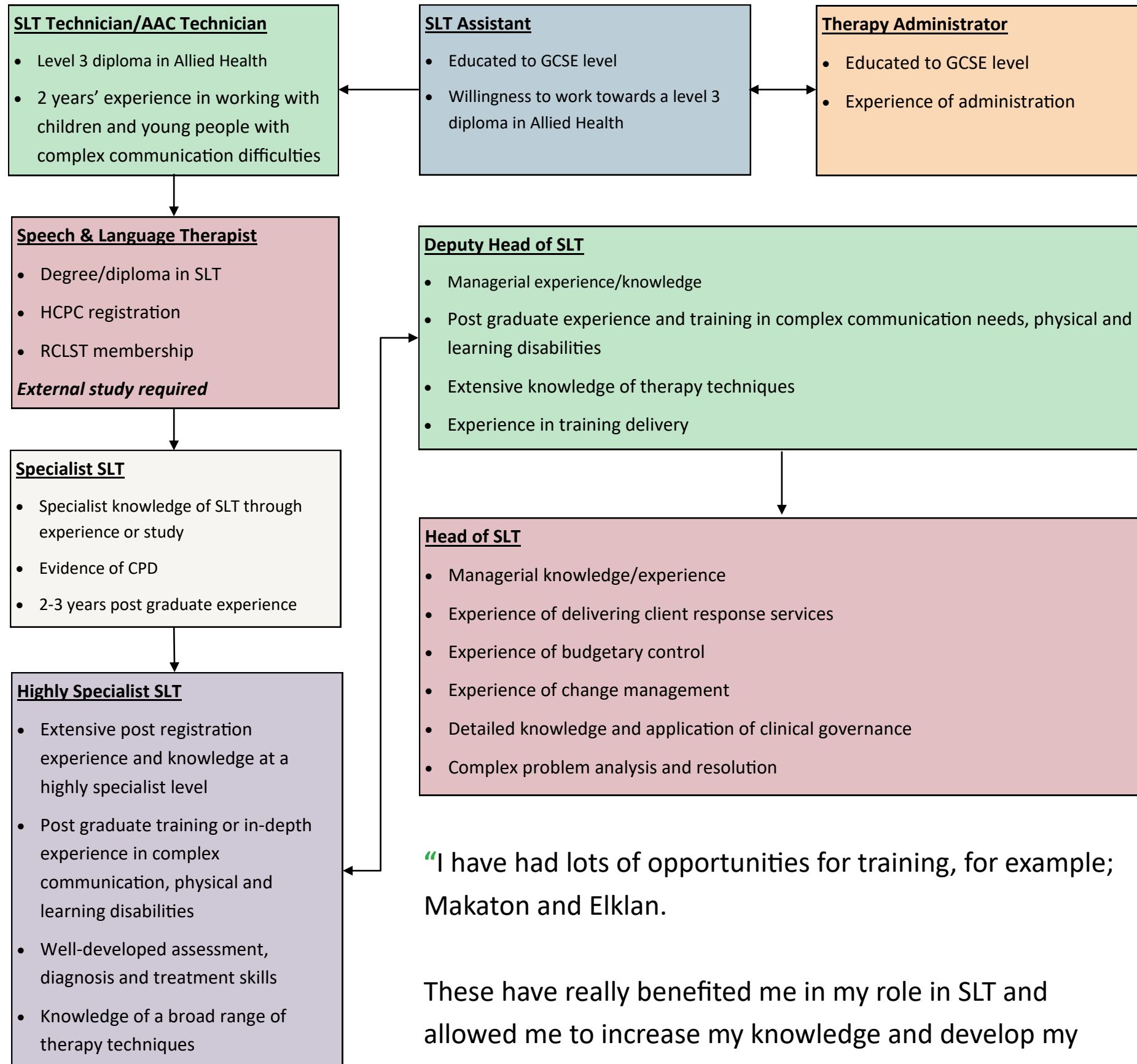

Progression Example
