OUTSTANDING SERVICE

Sansa House (below) is a lovely residential home which provides accommodation and personal care for five very special young people who are supported with complex needs, including learning disabilities and autism. Sansa House was rated overall outstanding for the second time by the Care Quality Commission (CQC) on our standard of care. Less than 5% of care homes are given this rating by CQC.



VALUES UNDERLYING OUR APPROACH

- Seeing beyond the disability – empathy, non-judgmental, supportive
- Meeting person where they are – co-worker adjust their approach, flexibility

- The diversity of Autism means no one single approach will work for everybody. We use a holistic approach to meeting people's needs in all areas of their life, and an eclectic approach to models of intervention to suit individual strengths and needs.
