Skilled resources

Assessment

Our assessment process begins with providing information about the services and support we can offer. Then a detailed assessment process commences which allows us to learn about the needs of each individual which subsequently enables us to identify which of our services is best suited for each person.

Transition

Upon the acceptance of a placement that is offered we work with everyone to design a person centred transition plan. The specific details and pace of the transition varies according to the needs of each person, some needing a detailed extended period of transition whilst others require a shorter more condensed period. The most important element is whatever is undertaken is driven by the needs of the young person.

Accommodation

In addition to the skilled support we have a wonderful range of high quality accommodation. The style and size of accommodation varies from individual supported living apartments within a complex of apartments, to shared supported living and shared residential services.
