


Aurora Orchard Manor

Welcome to Orchard Manor

Aurora Orchard Manor offers a supportive living and learning environment for young adults with severe and profound learning difficulties and complex health needs. With specialist facilities and a focus on promoting independence, we support each of our young people through the transition from education into adulthood.

With our team of highly-skilled teaching, support and therapeutic staff and a focus on Reliance, Collaboration, Responsibility and Creativity, we help each young person to build on their existing strengths and explore new skills and interests during their time with us, so that they can look forward to an independent future of their own choosing.

Our facilities and curriculum

Aurora Orchard Manor is situated in the village of Meldreth, on the border of Cambridgeshire and Hertfordshire. As a CQC 'Outstanding' registered care home, we offer flexible 52-week residential placements for up to 31 young people.

Our rooms are large and wheelchair-accessible and can be equipped with assistive technology where required. All the living areas have a kitchen where people are encouraged to get involved in choosing and preparing meals and a large lounge area where residents can relax and socialise with their house-mates.

Our facilities include a hydrotherapy pool and rebound therapy facility, sensory areas, extensive grounds with a range of outdoor spaces, and an on-site Skills Centre that is open to all our residents. The centre not only provides a space for learning and development – it is also a place where our young people can have fun, make friends and express themselves.



Supporting learning

Every young adult has the opportunity to try new experiences when they arrive at Aurora Orchard Manor. We offer a variety of activities through our Skills programme, including cooking, music, art, sensory, ICT and community activities such as shopping and swimming.

Young people at Aurora Orchard Manor also have the opportunity to learn work-related skills, develop their confidence and improve their communication skills by taking part in a range of fun social enterprise activities – past ventures have included making and selling soap, dog biscuits, cards, wrapping paper and chutney.

When a young person is ready to move on from us, they are supported to visit other places and explore the opportunities that are available. Our team supports both them and the staff at their new home to understand their needs and challenges and to facilitate the transition.
